Justin Hamilton is Adelaide's best comic with over six years experience in Australia and over seas including performing at the 'Sit'n'Spin' in Seattle and the prestigious 'Gershwin Room' in New York. Justin has been involved in shows at the Adelaide Fringe Festival since 1994. A weekly guest on Triple J Drive, Justin has also appeared on ABC TV's The Glass House. His good natured, high energy ranting has made him a favourite in his home town and the rest of Australia is catching on fast.

### Justin Hamiltons' Comedy Highlights

April 1994: Start comedy life in the Bunta Boys, a musical comedy duo.

Sept 1994: Bunta Boys support The Doug Anthony All Stars through their Adelaide tour.

Feb 1995: Justin starts his own comedy room "The Comedy Tree House" in Adelaide.

April 1995: Bunta Boys perform in the Melbourne Comedy Festival "Get Out Of The Shower" with the likes of David Williams and Jodi J Hill.

1995: Bunta Boys tour Melbourne on three occasions.

Feb - Mar 1996: Bunta Boys perform Adelaide Fringe Festival sell out show "Happy As All Buggery!"

April 1996: Bunta Boys perform in a Melbourne Comedy Festival show "You Can't Be Saying That!"

June 1996: Bunta Boys support Alexei Sayle Thebarton Theatre Adelaide.

Mar 1997: Adelaide Funny Business Comedy Festival invites the Bunta Boys to perform a season.

Mar 1998: Bunta Boys perform "Comedians In The Mist" in the Adelaide Fringe Festival with David Williams.

Dec 1998: Bunta Boys break up in final shows "Last Exit".

Mar 1999: Justin performs a solo season for the Adelaide Comedy Festival at the State Theatre.

April 1999: Justin takes "Sugar and Spite" to the Melbourne Comedy Festival with Lehmo.

1999: Justin tours the USA, performing at the "Sit'n'Spin" in Seattle and the "Gershwin

Room” in New York.

Feb - Mar 2000: Justin’s’ first solo show "Screw You Misery, I'm the Karaoke Guy!", performed at the Adelaide Fringe Festival is a critical and box office success.

April 2000: Solo season at the Baracudda Bar, as part of the Melbourne Comedy Festival.

May 2000: Justin opens “The Poster Comedy Show” comedy room in Adelaide.

2000: Justin tours Sydney and Melbourne.

Jan 2001: Justin opens a second room "Monkey Business" at the Rhino Room, which runs simultaneously to “The Poster Comedy Show”.

Feb - Mar 2001: Justin runs the South Australian heats of Raw Comedy.

2001: Justin tours Sydney and Melbourne on frequent occasions.  
Justin performs numerous guest spots on Triple J Breakfast.

August 2001: Justin and Mickey D sell out a season at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival with their show "The Indescribables".

Dec 2001: Justin is selected to perform at the Falls Festival for New Year's Eve.

Feb - Mar 2002: Justin runs the South Australian heats of Raw Comedy for a second year.

Feb - Mar 2002: "Father, Can You Spare A Dime?", Justin’s second solo Adelaide Fringe show, sells out.

April 2002: Justin performs at the Melbourne Comedy Festival again, this time with Lehmo and Mickey D. the show is entitled "Lehmo and Mickey D are in Justin Hamilton's Fingers".

April 2002: Appearance on ABC TV's “The Glass House”.

2002: Regular segment on Triple J Drive beginning in August.
